Sampling in the field in different habitats and sorting samples will be central in the course, followed by data analyses and discussions on the most advanced researches in marine ecology. The course will be also an unprecendent opportunity to understand the challenges of the direction of an MPA and the opportunities coming from the integration between scientific research and management.
