

CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION TO "ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAM" (BIP) AT THE UNIVERSITY OF FEDERICO II, NAPLES, DIRECTED TO BACHELOR' STUDENTS.

The call for applications is hereby published for the participation to "Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)" in *Regenerative Practices in Ercolano – creating cultural experiences in Ercolano* (BIP 2023-1-NL01-KA131-HED-000137741-2) from 04th September – 18th November 2024 online. from 18th to 23rd October 2024 (in presence). It will take place at Ercolano, Naples, Villa Campolieto as BIP home base.

BIPs are short-term Intensive Study Programs, which include in-person and online lessons. This program will prepare students with knowledge to consider how regenerative practices for managing cultural resources can lead to socially innovative interventions. In multidisciplinary project teams students will come up with sustainable concepts that contribute to a sustainable living environment and a resilient society for local people.

The call, having deadline on 07/08/2024 is addressed to students from the University of Naples Federico II who, at the moment of application, are regularly enrolled in the Bachelor programme, *at* 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of the first Cycle Degree programmes A.Y. 2023/2024: Biology

from 04th September – 18th November 2024 online.

from 18th to 23rd October 2024 (in presence). It will take place at Ercolano, Naples. All the activities will be hold exclusively in English, thus knowledge of English language is required and will be verified during the interview.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory) will receive an end-course certify mandatory to obtain 6 ECTS to spend as optional exam or traineeship or part of the thesis work.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Selection Committee will select 5 students. Applicants should be regularly enrolled for the a.y. 2023/24 at the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year of the **BIOLOGY** study course:

The selection will be carried out considering the student weighted average of exams, the credits done by the student compared to that to do for each year of bachelor and motivation letter.

3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Interested students must apply by the deadline, h 12:00 a.m. of 07/08/2024 using the form attached, the application with the documentation required must be sent via email to <u>uff.didattica.dib@unina.it</u> with the object "BIP ERCOLANO – Name, Surname".

The following documents must be enclosed:

- Transcript of record of sustained exams
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words)



The selection is the sole responsibility of the department of University of Naples Federico II and consists in cv evaluation and oral interview.

CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING
The Commission will assign the score as follows:
Max. 70 points for the evaluation of the academic career.
Max. 30 points for the motivation letter.
In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.
In case of equal score, the younger candidate will be favoured.

The selection will be carried out by the Erasmus Committee of Department of Biology

4. PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS

Rankings will be published on the Department's websites starting from 30th of August 2024.

5. AMOUNT OF THE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

The first 5 selected students will be financially supported from Inholland University for accommodation and a selection of activities.

6. PROCEDURE SUPERVISOR

Dr Fabiana Alfieri is responsible for any fulfilment related to this call for applications which does not fall under the responsibility of the Examining Boards. The aforementioned may assign in writing to another employee of the organizational unit the responsibility for the procedural requirements.

7. DATA PROCESSING

PURPOSES AND MEANS OF PROCESSING: The personal data provided during the application for participation or acquired subsequently during the relationship with the University will be processed for institutional purposes, for administrative and accounting obligations related to the agreement. To this end, personal data such as name, surname, residence, personal data, tax code, contact details, address, email, data relating to the qualifications held, to the school career may be collected.



Personal data will be processed by authorised personnel both electronically, through the computerized management of the data, and in paper mode, through the collection, storage, and use of documents in files, dossiers, and archives.

MANDATORY PROVISION OF DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF ANY REFUSAL: the processing of personal data is mandatory for the purpose of assessing the requirements for participation in the aforementioned call. Particular categories of data (judicial data and particular state of health) are provided voluntarily to allow the University to carry out the procedure and/or the provision of the related services for participation. For these reasons, consent to the processing of data is not required. Any refusal will make it impossible for the University to fulfil these purposes and participation in the program.
