

## FOR NON-EU STUDENTS

Introduction to the enrolment process The Bachelor's Degree Course in "Biology for One-Health" is part of the International Catalogue of the University of Napoli Federico II. The Course is taught in English and is open to Italian, EU and non-EU students (**maximum 75 students: 30 non-EU students and 45 EU and Italian students**).

### Pre-enrolment (only for non-EU students)

The pre-enrolment phase takes place online and culminates in receiving a pre-acceptance letter, required to obtain the entry visa for studying in Italy at the Italian Embassy/Consulate of the student's Nation. Holding a visa is a prerequisite for enrolment. Non-EU candidates must apply through the University website ([www.university.it](http://www.university.it)), the only gateway for obtaining a visa to study in Italy after registration. Applicants must indicate the University of Naples Federico II, choose the Bachelor's Degree Course in "Biology for One-Health" (Class L13) and specify the Embassy/Consulate where they will apply for the visa.

They must upload all the following required documents for the pre-acceptance selection:

- Passport
- Updated Curriculum Vitae
- High School Degree Certificate (prospective students should have obtained the High School Diploma after at least 12 years of pre-university education)
- Certificate of English language proficiency (at least B2 level)
- Letter/Letters of recommendation (optional, but useful for a positive assessment)

Once the application period on the University platform is over, non-EU candidates will be interviewed to test the personal preparation about logical ability and basic scientific knowledge. The candidates will receive an e-mail (at the same address indicated on the University pre-application), which will serve as official convocation and notification, with details about the interview. Only at the end of this procedure, after the publication of the final ranking list on the Biology Department ([www.dipartimentodibiologia.unina.it](http://www.dipartimentodibiologia.unina.it)), the Pre-Acceptance Letter for winners and successful candidates will be uploaded on the University website and the pre-application can be validated and sent to the Embassy/Consulate. From this moment the winners can start the process of visa issuing. The status of actual students is not assumed; therefore, the University of Naples Federico II is not responsible for managing the visa appointments and cannot interact with Embassy/Consulate.

NB: Pay attention that the pre-applications on the University platform will remain in no-validated status until the interviews are concluded.

### **Enrolment (for non-EU candidates)**

Requisites:

- At least 12 years of pre-university education (high school diploma)
- At least B2 level of the certificate of English language proficiency
- Positive evaluation of the interview after registration on University
- CEnT (CISIA English Test)

The document “Declaration of Value” has to be required at the embassies or consulates if the High School Diploma was obtained after at least 12 years of pre-university education at non-Italian schools.

The English language proficiency certificates accepted by the University of Naples Federico II are:

- Cambridge
- BEC
- Trinity
- IELTS
- TOEFL

The attainment of the B2 level of the certificate of English language proficiency will be ascertained by the University Language Centre ([www.cla.unina.it](http://www.cla.unina.it)) before the enrolment. It is worth noting that if individual English proficiency testing is carried out after enrolment, the procedure at Embassy/Consulate for non-EU visas could fail.

**Procedure:** ~~Non-EU candidates who have obtained or who already own the visa for studying in Italy must complete the enrolment process, submitting in person (online enrolment is not allowed) the required documents at the~~ Only by person at the Office for Biology study programs of the University of Naples Federico II (Segreteria Studenti - Area Didattica Scienze MM.FF.NN., via Cupa Nuova Cintia, 21 - 80126, Napoli, Italy).

~~The required documents to submit in person at the Segreteria Studenti to complete the enrolment are:~~

- ~~Passport (to be shown) + one copy to be left at the student office~~

- ~~— Italian tax code~~
- ~~— Proof of payment of tuition fees (e.g., deposit at the bank counter); actually, tuition fees coincide with the regional tax and the legal stamp, and they will be paid only after arriving in Italy~~
- ~~— Passport size photograph in .jpeg format~~
- ~~— Visa permit (to be shown) + one copy to be left at the student office~~
- ~~— Copy of the Pre-Acceptance Letter (to be shown) + one copy to be left at the student office~~
- ~~— DoV (declaration of value) or Cimea statement of comparability/verification. You can use ARDI tools (<https://www.cimea.it/EN/pagina-ardi-automatic-recognition-database-italia>) if you holder of qualifications from the 55 signatory countries of the Lisbon Recognition Convention to obtain an automatic correspondence of your qualification~~
- ~~— Copy of the English language proficiency certificate~~
- ~~— Report of the CEnT (CISIA English Test)~~
- ~~— Application form~~

~~The student status will be attained only at the time of final enrolment in person.~~
